Dr. Byong-Man AHN is Vice Chairman of the Presidential Advisory Council on Education, Science and Technology since January 2011. From 2008 to 2010 he was Minister for Education, Science and Technology. Under a clear vision to enhance the autonomy and creativity of schools, Dr. Ahn is making various policy endeavors to strengthen educational excellence.

Before joining the Ministry, Dr. AHN was Chairman of the Presidential Council for Future & Vision in 2008, and served as President and professor of the Hankuk University of Foreign Studies from 1975 to 2006, one of the premier institutions of higher education in Korea.

Dr. AHN was born in Seoul, Korea and earned his bachelor's and master's degrees in law from Seoul National University in 1964 and 1967, respectively, and he received a doctoral degree in political science at the University of Florida in 1974. Dr. AHN has authored numerous influential articles and books on politics and public administration.
